WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:18 a.m.: EXAMINER CATANACH: At this time I'll call Case 3 4 13,831, the Application of Pride Energy Company for 5 compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. 6 Call for appearances in this case. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, 7 representing the Applicant. I'm again submitting this by 8 affidavit. Mr. Examiner, submitted as Exhibit 1 is an 10 affidavit of the landman in this case. 11 This is another -- This is similar to the last 12 case, it's a Mississippian test seeking to force pool the 13 east half of Section 25, 11 South, 33 East, just to the 14 south of the prior case. Again, Pride seeks to pool 40-, 15 16 80-, 160- and 320-acre units. The Mississippian and the 17 Permo-Penn are the primary zones of interest.

On page 2 of Exhibit 1 is the list of the parties being pooled, and again Pride has reached agreement with Yates Petroleum, Yates Drilling, Abo Petroleum and MYCO Industries, and so those parties are not being pooled by this case.

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The other parties being pooled, again, are the two similar -- same as the last case, Dorothy Mae Fann and Doris Fleming, who did not have good addresses. And the

Barton group.

If you'll look at Exhibit A, again, this is a single fee tract, and all of the interest owners have uniform mineral interest throughout the half section.

Exhibit B is the correspondence to the parties asking them -- or proposing the well.

The final page of Exhibit B, attached to this exhibit, is a letter from Roy Barton stating that they do not wish to join in the well. They have made a lease offer, and I don't know if that has been accepted yet. I will determine that, and I will let the Division know if the Barton interests have leased rather than join in the well.

And attached as Exhibit C is the AFE for the well.

Exhibit 2 is my affidavit of notice, and all parties did receive actual written notice except, again, for the two, Dorothy Mae Fann and Doris Fleming. And this notice was published at the same time as the one for Section 24, and I did not receive that in the mail, so I'd ask that this case also be continued for two weeks so I can submit the affidavit of notice.

EXAMINER CATANACH: These are the same two parties that you couldn't find in the other one?

MR. BRUCE: That is correct.
