AMENDED APPLICATION OF KAI SER-FRANCIS OIL COMPANY FOR PROMULGA TION OF SPECIAL POOL RULES FOR THE EAST HAPPY VALLEY BONE SPRING POOL, FOR AN EXCEPTION TO THE GAS-OIL RATIO LIMITATION, AND ASSIGN MENT OF A SPECIAL DEPTH BRACKET AL LOWABLE, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO. Applicant seeks an order establishing special pool rules for the East Happy Valley Bone Spring Pool comprised of the W/2 of Section 11, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, NMPM providing for 160-acre spacing and proration units with the option for a second well locations, including 330', setback requirements. Applicant also seeks an exception from the gas oil ratio limitation under exception from the gas oil ratio limitation under Division Rule 506 A that would permit wells drill

ed within each proration unit within the pool to produce up to a GOR limitation of four thou sand cubic feet of gas for each barrel of oil produced, along with an increase in the depth bracket allowable to 382 under Division Rule 505. Applicant proposes that the applicability of the special pool rules be limited to the W/2 of the Mesa-Grande 11 Applicant is the operator of the Mesa-Grande 11 Well No. 2 (API No. 30 20 15 ? 3 7 2 0) completed in the Second 600 FWL (Unit L) of Section 11, 1725, RZ6E. The well and lands are located approximately ½ miles outhwest of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
