STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. seeks an exception to Rule 19.15.5.303A NMAC to authorize the surface commingling of production from the Ingle Wells-Delaware Pool originating from its wells located on Federal Oil and Gas Leases NM 0418220-A and NM 0405444-A, which collectively comprise all of Section 26, Township 23 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M.. Applicant also seeks an exception to the metering requirements of Rule 19.15.5.303B(4)(a) NMAC to authorize the allocation of production from these diversely-owned wells on the basis of periodic well tests. All production from these wells is to be stored at the Todd "26" Tank Battery, located in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 26.


