

NOTICE

To: Coille Limited Partnership; Nadel and Gussman Permian, L.L.C. seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the following described acreage in Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and in the following manner: The N/2 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Dublin Ranch-Morrow Gas Pool; the NW/4 to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations or pools developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent; and the NW/4NW/4 to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for all formations or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to the Big Chief Fee Well No. 10, to be drilled at an orthodox location in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 22. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, March 1, 2007 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date.
