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### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) seeks an order finding that Platinum Exploration Inc. (Platinum) knowingly and willfully violated 19.15.4.201 NMAC as to four inactive wells and assessing penalties for those violations. In addition, the OCD seeks an order requiring Platinum to return those wells to compliance by a date certain, and authorizing the OCD to plug the wells and forfeit the applicable financial assurance if Platinum does not comply. Platinum has posted \$50,000 letter of credit through West Texas State Bank in Odessa, Texas.

The four wells at issue in this case were the subject of inactive well agreed compliance order 123. That order has expired.
