

SNOW-REMOVAL VEHICLE LIGHTING

The New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department will hold a public hearing for the purpose of receiving oral or written public comment on SHTD Rule 95-1, Snow-Removal Vehicle Lighting. The purpose of this proposed rule is to ensure adequate lighting is provided for snow-removal vehicles engaged in hazardous operations on or alongside the roadway to protect employees and equipment and to warn the driving public.

The hearing is scheduled for March 28, 1995, from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at the

New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department, General Office/Training Center, 1120 Cerrillos Road, in Santa Fe, New Mexico.

The hearing will be held before a hearing officer appointed by the Secretary of the Highway and Transportation Department. Interested persons may also present their views by written statements submitted on or before March 17, 1995, to John E. Kemp, Safety Program Director, New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department, P.O. Box 1149, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-1149, (505) 827-3780.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The New Mexico Human Services Department will hold a public hearing on Friday, April 07, 1995, at 9:00 A.M., at Apodaca Hall, in the PERA Building, at the corner of Paseo De Peralta and Old Santa Fe Trail in Santa Fe, New Mexico.

The New Mexico Medicaid Program is proposing to revise the existing policy on pregnancy termination procedures to limit Medicaid coverage of abortions to those conditions reimbursed under federal law. They include:

1. the procedure is necessary to save the life of the mother;
2. the pregnancy is a result of rape or incest, or if not reported, the patient is not physically or emotionally able to report the incident; or
3. the procedure is necessary to terminate an ectopic pregnancy.

An increase in annual aggregate expenditures for the Human Services Department is expected from this change in regulation.

Interested persons may testify or submit written comments no later than 5:00 P.M., April 07, 1995, to Eugene D. Lovato, PhD., Secretary, Human Services Department, P.O. Box 2348, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-2348. All written and oral testimony will be considered prior to issuance of the final regulation.
