Any other continuances or dismissals? 24 25 MS. O'CONNOR: Yes, Mr. Hearing Examiner. Cheryl

5	EXAMINER JONES: Okay, that would be the end of

8	Any other continuances or dismissals?
9	Unfortunately not, I guess.
10	MR. EZEANYIM: Excuse me, on page 3 Case Number
11	13,814 was inadvertently put on this docket. It's not
12	supposed to be on this docket at all. It was taken care of
13	last I think March 1
14	EXAMINER JONES: Okay
15	MR. EZEANYIM: so you don't need to worry
16	about that.
17	EXAMINER JONES: Okay, thank you. Case 13,814 is
18	not even a part of this docket, so we'll have that on the
19	record.
20	An other continuances or dismissals? Okay.
21	MR. CARR: Mr. Examiner, Case 13,629 is a case
22	that was reopened by the Division concerning special pool
23	rules for the Sand Springs-Permo Upper Penn. Yates was the
24	Applicant in that original case. They've decided to let
25	the rules expire.

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EXAMINER JONES: Okay, I've never been involved 1 with a case where they've let that happen, so in that case 2 3 we just don't even call it this morning. We'll just dismiss this case --4 MR. CARR: That's fine with us. 5 EXAMINER JONES: -- and by default it will 6 7 expire, special pool rules. So Case 13,629 is dismissed. 8 Thank you. 9 (Off the record at 8:19 a.m.) 10 (The following proceedings had at 9:58 a.m.) 11 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, let's go back on the 12 record here, and I quess the first thing I need to do is 13 revisit Case Number 13,629. This morning I mentioned that the case will be 14 15 dismissed, and I will be writing an order in that case with the finding that Yates no longer wants these --16 MR. CARR: And --17 18 EXAMINER JONES: -- pools. 19 MR. CARR: Yes, sir. 20 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. 21 MR. CARR: And also, Mr. Examiner, there was a comment about a Pride case that was on the docket, and it 22 said it shouldn't be on the docket. There was an error on 23 24 that ad, and it has been readvertised for the hearing, I believe April the 12th. But you don't have to do anything, 25
