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1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 2 8:17 a.m.: 3 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, let's go on the hearing -go on the clock this morning, and let's call the Examiner 4 Hearing on March 15th, 2007. This is Docket Number 9-07. 5 6 I'm William V. Jones. This is David Brooks, 7 attorney for the Division this morning. Let's first call the continuances and dismissals, 8 9 and you can correct me if I'm wrong on some of these. 10 Page 1, Case Number 13,884 is dismissed. Case Number 13,885 is continued for six weeks; I take that to be 11 April the 26th. 12 13 MR. BROOKS: I believe that's right. EXAMINER JONES: If I'm wrong on that, we'll 14 continue it for six weeks. 15 16 On page 2, no continuances or dismissals. 17 On page 3, Case 13,872 is dismissed. 18 On page 4, Case [13,663] is continued to April 12th; Case 13,787 continued to April 12th; Case 13,493 19 20 continued to March 29th. 21 And on page 5, Case 13,853 is continued to March 22 29th; Case 13,856 continued to March 29th; Case 13,877 23 continued to April 12th. 24 Any other continuances or dismissals? 25 MS. O'CONNOR: Yes, Mr. Hearing Examiner.

O'Connor of the Oil Conservation Division, and we would like to continue the Case Number 13,886, Reubin Collins doing business as RCJ Enterprises. We would like to continue that for two weeks.

EXAMINER JONES: Okay, that would be the end of March, we'll continue -- March 29th, we'll continue that case.

CARR: That's fine with us. 5 EXAMINER JONES: -- and by default it will 6 expire, special pool rules. So Case 13,629 is dismissed. 7 Thank you. 8 (Off the record at 8:19 a.m.) 9 (The following proceedings had at 9:58 a.m.) 10 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, let's go back on the 11 record here, and I quess the first thing I need to do is 12 revisit Case Number 13,629. 13 This morning I mentioned that the case will be 14 dismissed, and I will be writing an order in that case with 15 16 the finding that Yates no longer wants these --17 MR. CARR: And --18 EXAMINER JONES: -- pools. MR. CARR: Yes, sir. 19 20 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. MR. CARR: And also, Mr. Examiner, there was a 21 22 comment about a Pride case that was on the docket, and it
