2 10:05 a.m.:

3 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: At this time we'll call to
4 order the June 29th regularly scheduled meeting of the New
5 Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

6 Let the record reflect that Commissioners Bailey,
7 Olson and Fesmire are all present. We therefore have a
8 quorum.

9 The matters before the Commission, the first
10 matter is the notes from the previous meeting, the May
11 17th, 2007, meeting that was held in the same location
12 we're at now, in Porter Hall.

13 Commissioner Bailey, did you get a chance to
14 review the minutes as presented by the Secretary?

15 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move
16 that we adopt them.

17 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Commissioner Olson, have you
18 had a chance to review them?

19 COMMISSIONER OLSON: Yes, I've reviewed them, and
20 I'll second that motion.

21 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, I too have reviewed
22 them. At this time, all in favor of adopting the minutes

11 authorizing increased well density and simultaneous
12 dedication on certain nonstandard spacing units in the
13 Basin-Fruitland Coal Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

14 Before the Commission today is an order that was
15 drafted and purportedly represents the decision of the
16 Commission at their deliberations on the May 17th meeting.

17 Commissioner Bailey, have you had a chance to
18 review that order?

19 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I will
20 sign it.

21 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, Commissioner Olson, have
22 you had a chance?

23 COMMISSIONER OLSON: Yes, I've reviewed it, and I
24 believe it accurately reflects the decision of the
25 Commission, and I'll second that.

1 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. I too have read the
2 order of the Commission, and it is my belief that it fairly
3 and accurately represents the decision the Commission made
4 in this case, and the Chair at this time will -- I'm sorry
5 Commissioner, did you move that we --

6 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I move that we adopt it.

7 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: That we adopt and sign the
8 order, all those in favor signify by saying aye.

9 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye.

10 COMMISSIONER OLSON: Aye.

11 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Aye.

12 Let the record reflect that the order was adopted
13 by the Commission and at this time will be signed by all
14 three Commissioners and transmitted to the secretary.
