Cimarex Energy Co. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conserva- tion Division seeking an order approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) comprised of the W/2SW/4 of Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, to form a non-standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for any and all formations or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Denton-Wolfcamp Pool, and pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the non-standard unit. The unit is to be dedicated to the Pyra- mid Well No. 1, a horizontal well to be drilled at a surface lo- cation 2210 feet from the south line and 430 feet from the west line, with a terminus 330 feet from the south line and 430 feet from the west line of Section 31. Also to be con- sidered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual op- erating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The appli- cation is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, June 21, 2007 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit, you have the right to enter an ap- pearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approxi- mately 7 miles east of Prairieview, New Mexico.
