WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 10:48 a.m.: 3 4 EXAMINER JONES: And let's go ahead and call Case 5 Number 13,958, Application of Devon Energy Production 6 Company, LP, for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New 7 8 Mexico. 9 Call for appearances. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, 10 representing the Applicant. I'm submitting this case by 11 affidavit. 12 EXAMINER JONES: Other appearances? 13 14 Okay, affidavit case. 15 EXAMINER JONES: Ken Gray didn't come up today, huh? 16 1.7 MR. BRUCE: No, when you look at the interest being pooled, you'll see why. 18 Mr. Examiner, I've handed you three exhibits. 19 Exhibit 1 is a verified statement of Ken Gray under 20 Division Rules to do this case by affidavit. Devon seeks 21 the pooling of the west-half equivalent of Section 2, 22 Township 22 South, Range 26 East, for all pools spaced on 23 24 320 acres. 25 The unit is to be dedicated -- There's an error

in paragraph 2.(b), the second portion of that paragraph, line 1. It says Perfecto State Com Well Number 1. That should be Well Number 2. But the location is correct. It's a directional well being drilled from Section 3 into Section 2. This is right adjoining the City of Carlsbad, so some machinations had to be made to get a location to drill the well.

The only party being pooled is a Mr. H.L. Boyd who owns just over -- well, less than 1/100 of a percent of an interest in this well. All of the other working interest owners or mineral owners are tied up in the well.

Exhibit A of Exhibit 1 is a land plat showing where this well is located.

Exhibit B is some information from the broker discussing Mr. Boyd, who last appeared of record in 1966. They've tried to track him down and couldn't track him down.

And Exhibit C is the AFE for the well. And Devon asserts that these are reasonable well costs. They seek a 200-percent risk charge against Mr. Boyd, and their drilling costs set out in the affidavit are \$6000 and \$600 per month.

Exhibit 2 is an affidavit of notice. I did mail notice to Mr. Boyd's last known address, and the letter came back.

And as a result, we published notice of the 1 hearing in the Carlsbad newspaper, and that affidavit of 2 3 publication is submitted as Exhibit 3. And with that we would ask that this matter be 4 5 taken under advisement. 6 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, this is just for 320-acre 7 gas. 8 MR. BRUCE: Yes. EXAMINER JONES: And let's see here -- and it's 9 10 all going to -- even the penetration point is going to be 11 standard? 12 MR. BRUCE: That's what I was informed of. 13 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. What happens if -- oh, wait, this is going to be a -- let's see, a completely 14 15 horizontal well, isn't it? Its -- surface hole 21 from the 16 north, 150 from the east. 17 MR. BRUCE: Of Section 3. 18 EXAMINER JONES: Oh, okay --MR. BRUCE: Yeah. 19 EXAMINER JONES: | -- of Section 3. 20 21 I think the hole will be one of the MR. BRUCE: S-shaped --22 23 EXAMINER JONES: S-shaped, okay. 24 Mike, do you have any questions? 25 MR. THOMAS: (Shakes head)
