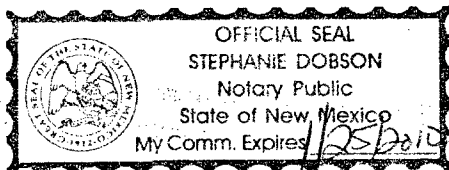

### NOTICE

To: H.L. Boyd, or his heirs, or devisees: Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying Lots 3, 4, S/2NW/4 and SW/4 (the W/2) of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, to form a standard 320.63 acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations spaced on 320 acres. The unit is to be dedicated to the Perfecto 2 State Com. Well No. 1, to be drilled from a surface location in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 3 (approximately 2100 feet from the north line and 150 feet from the

east line), Township 22 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M., to a bottomhole location in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 2 (approximately 1650 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line). Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, July 26, 2007 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approximately 2-1/2 miles west of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
