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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 8:20 a.m.:

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Well then, first of all on page 3, we call -- This case was heard sometime and taken under advisement, and we need to call it again to collect some information. This is the Application of Devon Energy Production Company for approval of five nonstandard gas spacing units, in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties.

Call for appearances.

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, representing the Applicant. I just have a short presentation to make.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Case Number 13,899. Are there any other appearances in this case?

Okay, Mr. Bruce.

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, you previously heard this case, and there were some additional notice issues.

And then one other item. If you'll look at the exhibits I've handed you, and this first one I've marked -It was original Exhibit 8. I've marked it Exhibit 8-A.
This is to address something that Mr. Brooks asked regarding the number of wells per well unit.

And if you'll recall, these are very nonstandard units, and they've been highlighted in the pink over on the left-hand side of Exhibit 8-A. And if you look at those

you will see that there are no more than -- I think, than the required number of wells per well unit, under the rules for the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool. And that's just -- that wasn't clear from the other exhibits.

And then the Division asked for notice material, so submitted as Exhibit 10 is a land plat. As noted in the Application, these wells are all in the Northeast Blanco Unit. The well units have been highlighted in black, and then the offset working interest owners have been identified, not only within the unit but outside the unit where there were well units impinging on the outside of the unit. And all of the working interest owners, offset working interest owners, are indicated on that plat.

And then Exhibit 11 is mailed notice sent out to all of those working interest owners. There was an Exhibit 9 whereby certain interest owners were notified of the first go-around, and these are additional -- Exhibit 11 shows additional mailing notice.

And there were a few people who did not -- we could not track down, so as a result Exhibit 12 is an affidavit of publication from the Farmington newspaper showing that notice was given to several people. Actually the only ones who did not receive mailed notice were James B. Fullerton and Henry G. Robledo.
