Chesapeake Operating Inc. ("Chesapeake") wishes to express its strong support for Apache Corporation's application to amend the special rules and regulations for the South Eunice-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. Apache seeks to amend the rules to allow for two wells to be located on each quarter-quarter section. Currently, the special rules allow for one well per quarter-quarter section in an 80-acre spacing unit.

Chesapeake is one of the largest operators in the South Eunice-San Andres Pool with approximately twelve wells producing or completed in this pool. To date the performance of our wells support the need for the special rules and regulations that are being considered.

Chesapeake believes that the granting of this application is in the best interest of conservation, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.
