It's the 15 Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for an order (1) 16 17 directing Pride Energy Company to reimburse Yates for well costs incurred by Yates in its attempt to re-enter the 18 State "X" Well Number 1, located in Section 12, Township 12 19 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, prior to the time that Pride Energy Company assumed operations of the well, and (2) 21 22 directing Pride Energy to account for and pay all sums it 23 is now improperly holding pursuant to expired orders of the Division and Commission, and (3) requiring Pride Energy to 24 plug and abandon the State "X" Well Number 1 in Lea County, 25

New Mexico. 1 2 Again at the request of counsel, this case has been continued to the February 8, 2007, Commission meeting. 3 4 5 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next case before the Commission is Case Number 13,695. It's the de novo 6 7 Application of Chaparral Energy, LLC, for approval of a 8 saltwater disposal well in Lea County, New Mexico.
