


APPLICATION

2. Applicant desires to drill the proposed Osudo 29 State Well No. 2, to be located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation.
3. The N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 29 is currently dedicated, in the Morrow formation, to the Osudo State Com. Well No. 1, located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22 and operated by Legacy Reserves Operating, LP ("Legacy").
