ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

- (1) By Order No. R-12819-A entered on October 25, 2007, the Oil Conservation Commission directed the parties to brief the following issues by November 7, 2007, at 5:00 P.M.:
 - (a) whether the proposed Subparagraph (c) of Paragraph (1) of Subsection F of 19.15.17.13 NMAC, which provides that surface owner consent is one of the requirements for on-site closure, violates the subsurface owners right to reasonable use of the surface and whether the Oil Conservation Commission has the authority to require surface owner consent; and
 - (b) whether the proposed requirement in Subparagraph (a) of Paragraph (1) of Subsection F of 19.15.17.13 NMAC that limits use of onsite closure to those situations where the proposed pit's location is outside of a 100-mile radius of a division-approved facility or an out-of-state waste management facility violates the Commerce Clause of the United States Constitution.
- (2) On October 30, 2007, the Oil Conservation Division filed a motion to extend the time for briefing because of the large volume of exhibits and pre-hearing statements that have been filed which require study prior to the commencement of the hearing on November 5, 2007.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The deadline for filing the above-described briefs is hereby extended to November 13, 2007 at 5:00 P.M.
