MYCO Industries, Inc. ("MYCO") is in receipt of the August 13, 2007 Beach Exploration, Inc ("Beach") letter regarding Beach's waterflood proposal.

Although we appreciate Beach's offer set out in its letter, MYCO is not at this time contemplating selling its interest, farming out its interest or installing cooperative lease line injectors.

MYCO is interested in participating as a working interest owner in the waterflood project if Beach is agreeable to doing a pilot project on the north end of the proposed waterflood to prove that a) the formation is conducive to waterflooding, b) the water availability is adequate for the waterflood and c) the technique that Beach proposes is effective. In the event the pilot project is successful, the balance of the proposed project could be included.

Please give this pilot project compromise proposal your consideration. If this compromise is agreeable to Beach, we would enter into a mutually agreeable contract setting out the relevant terms.

Please understand that MYCO does not desire to stand in the way of Beach's proposal. MYCO's desire is to test the idea Beach has presented before committing time and capital to a project it is unsure of. We understand that Beach has a level of comfort that MYCO does not have; thus this compromise proposal.

In accordance with our recent telephone conversation wherein you expressed concerns about various issues that MYCO has with our waterflood proposal, Beach would like to again mention several options that you might consider in lieu of participating as a working interest partner in the proposed unit as follows:

- 1. Consider selling your interest in the BBOC State #1,2,3,4 wells to Beach
- 2. Consider a Farmout, retaining an override convertible at payout of unit installation and operating costs to an APO working interest in the unit
- 3. Beach would also like to propose (as a matter of compromise) that if you cannot agree to Participate, Sell or Farmout, we would consider excluding the N/2 of Section 11, T-19-S, R-29-E from the unitized area in exchange for your agreement to install cooperative lease line injectors consisting of two injection wells operated by Beach and two injection wells operated by MYCO located in the N/2 of said Section 11.

As we also discussed, Beach has presented both MYCO and Devon with our third party engineering study as well as internal engineering and geological information supporting our analogies of successful Queen Waterfloods located in the area of our proposed waterflood. To date we have not received <u>any</u> reciprocal information from <u>either</u> Devon or MYCO regarding the concerns you have expressed about the floodability of the Queen formation.

We would appreciated the opportunity to meet with, and/or exchange information with, any of MYCO or Devon's technical people regarding their work on Queen waterflood analogies that can demonstrate your concerns.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Dear Shari:

I am in receipt of your letter dated July 3, 2007 regarding MYCO's concerns about our proposed waterflood. I would like to take this opportunity to address those concerns as follows:

- 1. Water Source: Beach has and will continue to evaluate all possible water sources for the waterflood. Beach, as operator, has installed two other waterfloods in this area and we are aware of the cost significance of the source water to the overall economics of the project. It is, however, our understanding that while the Oil Conservation Division discourages the use of fresh water, they will still approve using fresh water, as we did in our West High Lonesome Unit, if we can justify its use compared to the other water sources.
- 2. <u>Formation communication</u>: We have included with this letter a copy of our waterflood study conducted by T. Scott Hickman and Associates, Inc., wherein they concluded that our proposed waterflood should be successful. We would like very much to receive a copy of your study (New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology) as well as any other information that you might have regarding failed Queen waterfloods in this area. Our most recent waterflood (West High Lonesome Unit) as well as the immediately adjacent Turkey Track Unit and numerous other Queen waterflood units in this area seem to present very strong evidence that the Queen formation is very conducive to waterflooding. For <u>our</u> purposes, these various units <u>are</u> our pilot projects.
- 3. <u>Cost breakdown</u>: We have provided herewith, a cost estimate detailing the breakdown of the \$2,500,000 estimated installation cost. The unit plan, including injection well conversions and the proposed re-entry have been provided to you previously. We are still evaluating which wells located both inside and outside the unit boundaries may need to be plugged or re-plugged. We do, however, still feel that our estimated unit cost has budgeted enough money to cover required replugging expenses. Ultimately, however, plugging requirements will be

determined by the OCD and any cost revisions up or down will be made at that time.

- 4. Environmental concerns: Beach has conducted an inspection of the surface and associated production facilities and the individual well files of the Eastland wells. The OCD has also inspected the Eastland property over the years and we believe Eastland is in compliance with OCD requirements. If Beach encounters any environmental damage during the installation, we will clean up and remediate the damage as encountered.
- 5. <u>Pilot Project</u>: Due to the impressive success of the Queen waterfloods in this area both recently and over a long number of years, we do not believe that a pilot project would be either prudent or cost effective considering how long this technology has been widely used to waterflood the Queen formation. Our West High Lonesome Unit has been highly successful for both the working interest and royalty owners and we feel that a pilot project would only delay similar success and possibly add significantly to the installation cost of the entire unit. While we also appreciate your concern about 'watering out' your existing wells to the south, we feel that if the Queen formation is not communicated as projected by MYCO, our flood should have no effect on these wells. Other possible effects on the wells to the south might actually be beneficial with a possible increase, in present low oil production rates.

As mentioned above, please provide us with a copy of your waterflood study as well as any other specific information you might have regarding your position on this matter so that we can take an objective look at any issues that we might need to consider. The planning and installation of a waterflood unit is an evolving process during which some questions or issues may not be resolved completely to your satisfaction at this stage of said process. Beach does appreciate input from MYCO or any other working interest owner and we would be remiss not to consider any evidence you might have that would require us to change our proposal as presented.

MYCO Industries, Inc. and Sharbro Oil Ltd. Co ("MYCO") are in receipt of the Eastland Queen Waterflood Unit paperwork, including the Operating Agreement, the Unit Operating Agreement and the Waterflood Development Costs. It was our understanding that Beach Exploration, Inc. ("Beach") is preparing for a hearing in front of the Oil Conservation Division in August. If this is not the case, please let us know.

We appreciate the meeting we had on June 6, 2007 with your engineer, Jack Rose. Mr. Rose was quite knowledgeable and informative. During our meeting with Mr. Rose, we voiced a couple of concerns. Briefly, those concerns are:

- 1. Water source: It is MYCO's understanding that fresh water is no longer allowed in a waterflood unit. MYCO does participate in some waterflood units that use fresh water but those were in existence prior to the practices that the Oil Conservation Division has been following of late. We believe the success of this unit depends, in part, on the costs of the water source. MYCO must respectfully postpone making a decision on Beach's proposal until this issue is resolved.
- 2. <u>Formation communication</u>: It is MYCO's understanding that the Queen formation in this area is not conducive to waterflood. As we mentioned in the meeting, several years ago MYCO contemplated conducting a waterflood in this area but prior to doing so, engaged the New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology to conduct a study to examine the potential for improved oil recovery by waterflooding. The conclusion of the study confirmed that a waterflood project would not be successful in the Oueen in this area.

- MYCO respectfully requests that Beach consider the idea of conducting a pilot project as described below in item #5.
- 3. Cost breakdown: We acknowledged the cost breakdown you provided our office for the estimated \$2,500,000 for the proposed unit. We have requested additional information such as a) which P&A well Beach plans to convert to injection, b) which 13 wells will be used for injection, c) which 17 producing wells will be reconditioned, and d) what 4 abandoned wells in the unit area are to be re-plugged. Also, if there are any wells outside the unit area that need to be plugged, we would appreciate knowing that as well as an estimate of costs.
- 4. <u>Environmental concerns</u>: MYCO respectfully suggests that an environmental assessment be conducted on the proposed unit so that all parties are informed as to the presence of any potential environmental liabilities that would be assumed by unitization.
- 5. Pilot Project: As we mentioned in the Jack Rose meeting and again in a phone conversation with Bob Hinson on this day, MYCO respectfully requests that Beach consider conducting a pilot project at the north end of the proposed unit prior to doing the entire unit. MYCO is not convinced that a waterflood would be an effective means of secondary recovery in the Queen formation in this area. On the other hand, we understand that there is the possibility that a pilot project might prove that a waterflood is exactly what the Queen formation needs. MYCO has a great concern about watering out wells it produces on the south end of your proposed unit.

Please take some time to consider the ideas mentioned in this letter. In the meantime, MYCO will look forward to receiving additional information on the water issue and more details on the cost breakdown.

Dear Overriding Royalty Owner:

Beach is proceeding with plans to unitize 1,040 total acres located in Sections 1, 2 and 11, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico to implement a waterflood for secondary recovery purposes in the Queen Sand interval located at approximately 2,400' in the proposed unit area.

Our records indicate that you own an overriding royalty interest in certain producing oil wells that are located with the boundaries of our proposed Eastland Queen Waterflood Unit. The area covered by our proposed unit is shown outlined on Exhibit "A" of the subject Unit Agreement (copy attached), while your individual interest is shown in Exhibits "B" and "B-1".

Ultimate primary reserves have been used to calculate the tract participation for each tract in the Unit as shown in Exhibit "C" to the Unit Agreement. Your individual interest was determined using this tract participation factor to calculate your interest in the entire Unit. The form of Unit Agreement was prepared on the exact form of agreement required by the Commissioner of Public Lands.

Most of the producing wells in the unit outline have either already reached their economic limit, or are very close. Any significant future value that you will receive from your overriding royalty interest will be dependent upon Beach installing a successful waterflood. Our engineering study from T. Scott Hickman & Assoc. projects that a successful flood should recover additional 733,899 barrels of oil.

As an overriding royalty owner, your interest in the unit is free and clear of all costs incurred by Beach during the Unit installation and the future operation of said Unit.




