WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 10:57 a.m.:

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: We're going to go to page 2

now and call Case Number 13,825. This is the Application of Pride Energy Company to reinstate Order Number R-12,713 for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico.

Call for appearances.

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, representing the Applicant. I just have a brief presentation, no witnesses.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Any other appearances? Okay, go ahead.

Before I continue, Mr. Bruce just left and we have Assistant General Counsel Michael Thomas as the legal assistant, so we can proceed now, for the record.

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, this case is a reopened or -- yeah, a reopened case. First of all, before I forget, I had several cases for Pride Energy with similar property descriptions, and I filed this case as Case 13,825 Reopened and Order Number R-12,713 regarding the pooling of the south half, northeast quarter of Section 9, 11 South, 33 East. Actually, it's Case 13,824, and Order 12,712.

I have corrected that with the Division secretary, and the case is being readvertised for the 20th.

But -- Those numbers were wrong, but all the property

17	MR. BRUCE: Yeah, no.
18	Mr. Examiner, this case if I can go forward, I
19	did as I said, I did correct that with the Division
20	Secretary. And so I've handed you three exhibits, which is
21	the affidavit of the of a person from Pride Energy, and
22	it does have the correct case number on it
23	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Oh, okay.
24	MR. BRUCE:824.
25	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Yeah, okay.

MR. BRUCE: And they are seeking to force pool the south half, northeast quarter of Section 9. Page 2 of Exhibit 1 shows the persons who are being force pooled. There are some very small interests. And the other information regarding overhead rates and the AFE are in this exhibit.

This well is a Permo-Penn test -- EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Uh-huh.

MR. BRUCE: -- and it was -- it is at an unorthodox location. That was previously approved, so I don't need an unorthodox location.

EXAMINER EZEANYIM: It's already approved, okay.

MR. BRUCE: And notice was given to the pertinent interest owners. There were four locatable interest owners, Pure Energy, Virginia Glenn, Edge Petroleum and Chisos, who were notified. And if you'll look at the prior case record of 13,824 there were two parties who were unlocatable, Judith A. Bench and Judith A. Moseley [sic], Deborah Bench, a/k/a Deborah Smith, who were unlocatable.

And Exhibit 3 is an affidavit of publication in the Hobbs newspaper regarding these people. No protests have been received. These people all own, as you can see, fairly small interests. We are force pooling about -- oh, about five or six percent of the well unit.

And I would ask that this case be continued so

that the proper advertisement is on September 20th, and on 1 September 20th, I'd merely ask that this case be taken 2 under advisement. 3 Thank you. 4 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: But I have a couple of 5 questions for you. 6 7 MR. BRUCE: Yes, sir. 8 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Do you have that NSL order 9 that approved the unorthodox location? 10 MR. BRUCE: Actually, it would be the original Order 12,712 that did approve the unorthodox location. 11 Notice was given to the pertinent offset of that well. 12 And I don't think an unorthodox location expires with the 13 14 pooling order. 15 Okay, now -- no unorthodox EXAMINER EZEANYIM: 16 location doesn't expire. But now so it will be an amendment of Order Number R-12,712? 17 18 MR. BRUCE: Correct. 19 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: You see that 12,713? 20 MR. BRUCE: Yeah, correct. 21 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Yeah, you sent me on a 22 different point, so --23 MR. BRUCE: And I will send you a follow-up 24 letter just to clarify that, Mr. Examiner. 25 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Oh, okay, that will be --

2	And you said your overhead rates somewhere here.
3	Do you have overhead rates?
4	MR. BRUCE: Yes, overhead rates are on the second
5	page of Exhibit third page of Exhibit 1, \$7330 and \$767
6	per month.
7	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Just like the original order.
8	MR. BRUCE: That's correct, nothing changes.
9	They missed the commencement well-commencement deadline
10	by one day, and so
11	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: And one other question is,
12	why did they miss that? What happens?
13	MR. BRUCE: In this area they are very active,
14	and they just failed to get the rig. I mean, they've been
15	moving rigs around from location to location. They have
16	several ongoing wells in this area and other locations, and
17	they just by the time they got the request in to me, I
18	couldn't get a letter over to the Division Director to
19	request an extension.
20	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay. So the Order Number
21	12,713, there is no with that? That's
22	MR. BRUCE: That's wrong.
23	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay.
24	MR. BRUCE: -712.
