Case 14,035 is dismissed; Case 14,036 is continued to 1 2 December 13th. On page 7, Case 14,037 is continued to December 4 13th. Case 14,039 is continued, but I'm not sure to 5 when at this point. Mr. Bruce has requested that it be 6 continued to December 13th, and Mr. Padilla has requested 8 that it be continued to January the 4th. MR. BRUCE: Yeah, if we could just continue it 9 10 for two weeks, and I'll talk to Mr. Padilla after the hearing. 11 MR. PADILLA: That would be fine. 12 I thought we continued this case for two weeks, 13 and the Encore Acquisition case, which is number 27 on the 14 15 docket, that will be -- ask to be continued to January 16 24th. EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, Case Number 14,039 is 17 continued to December 13th. 18 Do I understand, then, Mr. Padilla, that Case 19 20 Number 13,942 is to be continued also --MR. PADILLA: Yes. 21 EXAMINER BROOKS: -- to December 13th? 22 MR. PADILLA: No, we had asked that one be 23 continued to January 4th. 24 25 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, Case Number 139,402 [sic]

appropriate date to continue. Okay, so it won't have to be 1 2 re-noticed. Okay, any other continuances and dismissals? MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, on page 5 --5 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, MR. BRUCE: -- Case 17, 13,981, please dismiss 6 7 that case. EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, Case Number 13,981 will 8 9 be dismissed. MR. BRUCE: And I don't know if I heard you. 10 The 11 one right below that, I also request that that be continued for two weeks. 12 EXAMINER BROOKS: I think I announced that, but 13 if I didn't Case 14,032 is continued to December 13th. 14 15 Any others?
