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1 MR. FESMIRE: At this time, we're going to
2 call the January 22nd regularly scheduled New Mexico Oil
3 Conservation Commission meeting to order.

4 Let the record reflect that Commissioners
5 Bailey and Fesmire are present, Commissioner Olson is
6 not present; however, two members of the Commission are
7 a quorum, and we are authorized by law to go ahead and
8 conduct business as the Commission this morning.

9 The first case on the docket is Case Number
10 13870, the application of Quest Cherokee, LLC, for
11 approval of an application for a permit to drill in Lea
12 County, New Mexico.

13 This case will be continued to the March 13th,
14 2008, regularly scheduled Commission meeting.

15 The next case is Case Number 13962. It is the
16 application by Gandy Corporation for authorization to
17 inject.

18 This case also will be continued to the
19 March 13th, 2008, regularly scheduled Commission
20 meeting.

21 The next case on the docket is Case Number
22 13812. This case is the application of Coleman Oil &
23 Gas, Inc., for an amendment of Administrative Order
24 SWD-806-B, in San Juan County, New Mexico.

25 This case also will be continued to the

1 March 13, 2008, regularly scheduled Commission docket.

2 The next case is Case Number 13945.

3 This case will be continued to the March 13th,
4 2008, Commission meeting.

5 It's the application of Occidental Permian,
6 Ltd., for cancellation of a drilling permit, for a
7 determination of the right to drill and approval of a
8 drilling permit, in Lea County, New Mexico.

9 The next case is Case Number 13912, the
10 application of EOG Resources, Inc., for compulsory
11 pooling, in Lea County, New Mexico.

12 This case is also continued to the March 13th,
13 2008, Commission meeting.

14 And the last case scheduled today is Case
15 Number 14000. This is the application of Harvey E.
16 Yates Company for expansion of a unit area, in Otero
17 County, New Mexico.

18 And this case will be continued to the
19 March 13th, 2008, regularly scheduled Commission
20 meeting.

21 Also before the Commission today is the
22 reading of the minutes of the last regular -- the
23 October 22nd, 2007, Commission meeting -- excuse me --
24 of the --

25 MS. BADA: December 6th.

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1 MR. FESMIRE: -- December 6th, 2007,
2 Commission meeting.

3 The minutes have been prepared and presented
4 to the Commission by the Commission secretary.

5 Commissioner Olson -- Commissioner Bailey,
6 have you had a chance to review the minutes as
7 presented?

8 MS. BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move that we
9 adopt them.

10 MR. FESMIRE: I will second that.

11 All those in favor signify by saying aye.

12 MS. BAILEY: Aye.

13 MR. FESMIRE: Aye.

14 Let the record reflect that the Commission
15 adopted the minutes as presented, that they will be
16 signed by the Chairman and transmitted to the secretary.

17 The next order of business before the
18 Commission is the adoption of a resolution establishing
19 the procedures for giving notice of meetings of the New
20 Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

21 Commissioner Bailey, have you had a chance to
22 review this resolution?

23 MS. BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move that we
24 adopt it.

25 MR. FESMIRE: I, too, have reviewed the

1 resolution and will second that motion.

2 All those in favor signify by saying aye.

3 MS. BAILEY: Aye.

4 MR. FESMIRE: Aye.

5 Let the record reflect that the resolution was
6 adopted by both members of the Commission present, who
7 will sign it and transmit it to the secretary for
8 recording.

9 MS. BADA: Okay. This meeting is to make up
10 for how long March is going to be, right?

11 MR. FESMIRE: Let the record reflect that the
12 resolution was signed and transmitted by both members of
13 the Commission present and transmitted to the secretary.

14 Is there any other evidence before the
15 Commission this morning -- any other business before the
16 Commission this morning?

17 MS. BAILEY: No.

18 MR. FESMIRE: Is there a motion for
19 adjournment?

20 MS. BAILEY: I move that we adjourn.
