Undesignated North-Cass Draw-Wolfcamp Gas Pool. These units are to be dedicated to the Wiggins Well No. 1 (API No. 2015-35789) to be directional drilled as a gas well from a surface location located from the North Pole 150 ft from the East line (Unit B), to standard bottom hole depth 660 feet from the surface.
