REPORTER'S CERTIFICATE

WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at
8:15 a.m.:
EXAMINER BROOKS: Good morning, ladies and
gentlemen.
We're in makeshift quarters this morning, but
this is Docket Number 38-07 of the Oil Conservation
Division.
I'm David Brooks, the Hearing Examiner for this
morning.
We will begin this morning, as is customary, by
announcing continuances and dismissals.
On page number 2, Case Number 13,990 is continued
till December 13th.
Case Number 14,025 is continued to December 13th
this is on page 3, sorry Case Number 14,026 is
continued to December 13th; Case Number 14,027 is continued
to December 13th; Case Number 13,891 is dismissed; Case
Number 14,016 is continued to December 13th.
On page 4, Case Number 14,017 is continued to
December 13th; Case Number 14,018 is continued to December
13th; Case Number 13,960 is continued to December 13th;
Case Number 14,028 is continued to December 13th.
On page 5, Case 14,031 is continued to December
13th; Case 14,032 is continued to December 13th.
Case Number 14,035 is this is on page 6

Case 14,035 is dismissed; Case 14,036 is continued to 1 2 December 13th. On page 7, Case 14,037 is continued to December 3 13th. 4 Case 14,039 is continued, but I'm not sure to 5 when at this point. Mr. Bruce has requested that it be 6 7 continued to December 13th, and Mr. Padilla has requested 8 that it be continued to January the 4th. MR. BRUCE: Yeah, if we could just continue it 9 for two weeks, and I'll talk to Mr. Padilla after the 10 11 hearing. MR. PADILLA: That would be fine. 12 13 I thought we continued this case for two weeks, and the Encore Acquisition case, which is number 27 on the 1415 docket, that will be -- ask to be continued to January 16 24th. 17 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, Case Number 14,039 is continued to December 13th. 18 Do I understand, then, Mr. Padilla, that Case 19 20 Number 13,942 is to be continued also --21 MR. PADILLA: Yes. EXAMINER BROOKS: -- to December 13th? 22 MR. PADILLA: No, we had asked that one be 23 24 continued to January 4th. 25 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, Case Number 139,402 [sic]

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1	is continued to January 4th, 2008.
2	And on the last page, nothing.
3	There was one other case that we had a motion for
4	continuance, I had not confirmed with opposing counsel.
5	That was Case Number 14,033 on page 6.
6	MR. BRUCE: Yeah, the Synergy case, Mr. Examiner.
7	I did speak with Mr. Hall, and actually Mr. Hall and his
8	co-counsel in this matter, Mr. Larson, have both actually
9	formally requested a continuance, so I don't think there's
10	any objection.
11	MR. HALL: That's correct, Mr. Examiner.
12	EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, Case Number 14,033 is
13	continued to December 13th.
14	Any other continuances or dismissals?
15	MR. HALL: Mr. Examiner, page 7, Case 13,751 is a
16	pool rules case. We had requested that that case be
17	continued for six months and had conferred with Mr.
18	Williams in Hobbs and Mr. Jones here in Santa Fe. They
19	agreed to that request.
20	EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, I don't have a list of
21	the hearings, and we're supposed to continue to a specific
22	date. Before I adjourn this hearing I will check on that
23	and find out
24	MR. HALL: Just the first hearing date in June
25	EXAMINER BROOKS: what would be the

appropriate date to continue. Okay, so it won't have to be 1 2 re-noticed. Okay, any other continuances and dismissals? 3 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, on page 5 --4 5 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, MR. BRUCE: -- Case 17, 13,981, please dismiss 6 7 that case. 8 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, Case Number 13,981 will be dismissed. 9 MR. BRUCE: And I don't know if I heard you. The 10 one right below that, I also request that that be continued 11 for two weeks. 12 13 EXAMINER BROOKS: I think I announced that, but 14 if I didn't Case 14,032 is continued to December 13th. 15 Any others? 16 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Mr. Examiner, on page 8, case 17 number 29, Case 13,940. Mr. Bruce and I just conferred, and he would like to continue that case for a month to 18 January 10th. 19 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, we continued one to 20 21 January 4th. Is there -- is --22 MS. MUNDS-DRY: I think the first hearing date in January is the 10th. 23 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, I think you're probably 24 25 right, but let me -- to make sure we don't make any errors

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in the docket, the one I had announced continued to January 1 2 the 4th was 13,942 --MR. BRUCE: The 4th would be a Friday. 3 EXAMINER BROOKS: That's probably not the date, 4 5 so... Well, now there's a problem here, the 4th is a 6 Friday -- no, the 4th is not -- the 4th -- You're right, 7 the 4th is a Friday, because 1st is a Tuesday. 8 But the 10th could not -- the 10th would be a 9 Saturday, and -- No, 3rd to the 10th, that's right, 10 11 Thursday. Okay, that's -- the 10th is probably right, but 12 I'll verify that before I adjourn the hearing today. 13 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. 14 15 EXAMINER BROOKS: Thank you. 16 Did you have a continuance? MR. PADILLA: The 10th is the right date and --17 the 10th is --18 EXAMINER BROOKS: Yes ---19 20 MR. PADILLA: -- the right date. EXAMINER BROOKS: -- well, the reason that I want 21 to be precise about it is because under our rules it says 22 you must continue to a date certain. And if you don't, 23 24 then arguably the case has to be re-noticed, and I don't want to put anybody to that trouble if it's not necessary, 25

2	MR. PADILLA: We wanted to continue it for
3	approximately a month. That should do it.
4	EXAMINER BROOKS: That would be fine, okay.
5	(Off the record at 8:25 a.m.)
6	(The following proceedings had at 10:00 a.m.)
7	EXAMINER BROOKS: In the absence of the
8	Division's counsel, I can clarify for the record that
9	during the break I have ascertained that Ms. Munds-Dry is
10	correct about the Division's hearing dates. We appreciate
11	your setting us straight.
12	MR. PADILLA: I took that from the website. You
13	know, I don't know, I saw it January 4th
14	EXAMINER BROOKS: So accordingly in accordance
15	with that determination, Case Number 13,942 will be
16	continued until January 10th.
17	Case Number 13,940 will be continued until
18	January 10th.
19	And which was the case I'm not finding it
20	here. Which was the case that was to be continued for six
21	months? Does anybody have that information available?
22	MR. BRUCE: That was that pool rules case.
23	EXAMINER BROOKS: Oh, wildcat, okay, yeah
24	MS. MUNDS-DRY: I think it's
25	EXAMINER BROOKS: Case Number 13,751 is continued
