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- 1 MR. BROOKS: Okay. Let's go back on the record. At
- 2 this time, we'll call Case No. 14104, the Application of
- 3 Trilogy Operating, Inc., for compulsory pooling, Lea County,
- 4 New Mexico.
- 5 Call for appearances.
- 6 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe,
- 7 representing the applicant. I'm submitting this case by
- 8 affidavit.
- 9 MR. BROOKS: Very good, Mr. Bruce. You may proceed.
- 10 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I submit as Exhibit 1 an
- 11 affidavit of Ken Dickeson, who is a contract landman for
- 12 Trilogy Operating, Inc. Trilogy seeks the forced pooling of
- 13 the southeast, southeast Section 24, 19 South, 38 East from the
- 14 surface to the base of the Abo Formation.
- The affidavit sets forth the name of the well, the
- 16 Allar Well No. 1, the parties being pooled -- there are four of
- 17 them -- about six percent total unleased working interests or
- 18 mineral interests in the well unit.
- 19 The overhead rates requested are \$4500 per month for
- 20 a drilling well and \$500 a month for a producing well. The
- 21 parties being pooled are Dorothy Groves Brady, and then
- 22 Ms. Brady as attorney-in-fact for Wyatt Tate Brady, Muirfield
- 23 Resources Company, and Jaqueline Faye Daugherty.
- The correspondence to those parties are attached as
- 25 Exhibit B, as is the affidavit for the well, which is a new

- 1 drill with an estimated cost of \$1.1 million.
- Exhibit 2 is my affidavit of mailing to the interest 2
- 3 The mailing went out to a couple of additional people,
- Phillip Grant, Jr. and Noel G. Wood, who have subsequently 4
- 5 joined in the well, and we do not seek the force-pooling of
- 6 those people.
- 7 Muirfield Resources and Jaqueline Fay Daugherty
- received their mail, but the notices that were sent out to 8
- 9 Dorothy Groves Brady came back. As a result, publication was
- 10 made as against Dorothy Groves Brady and Wyatt Tate Brady.
- 11 That affidavit of publication is submitted as Exhibit 3.
- 12 MR. BROOKS: It looks like also Noel G. Wood?
- 13 MR. BRUCE: He is not being pooled.
- MR. BROOKS: Okay. 14
- 15 MR. BRUCE: They subsequently located him and leased
- 16 his interest.
- 17 MR. BROOKS: Okay.
- 18 MR. BRUCE: And I would move the admission of
- 19 Exhibits 1 through 3.
- 20 MR. BROOKS: Exhibits 1 through 3 are admitted.
- 21 Very good. If there's nothing further, Case
- 22 No. 14104 will be taken under advisement.
