**Case No. 14130: Application of Energen Resources Corporation for Compulsory Pooling and Unorthodox Well Location, Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Fruitland Coal formation, (Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool) underlying the W/2 of Section 22, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, forming a standard 320-acre spacing and proration unit to be dedicated to the 32-5 Unit Well No. 115. The well will be directionally drilled from an unorthodox surface location 120 feet from the South line and 50 feet from the East line of Section 22 in Rio Arriba County, penetrating the Fruit land Coal formation at an unorthodox point 50 feet from 2, to a standard bottom hole location 660 feet from the North and West lines of Section 22 in Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM in San Juan County, New Mexico.
