IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF MYCO INDUSTRIES, INC. FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

MYCO INDUSTRIES, INC. ("Myco"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17, for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in all formations from the surface to the base of the Delaware formation underlying the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, to form a standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 40-acre spacing included but not limited to the Undesignated Catclaw Draw Delaware Pool.

In support of this application Myco states:

- 1. Myco is a working interest owner in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 15 and has a right to drill thereon.
- 2. Myco proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing or proration unit to its Basin 15 Federal Well No.1, to be drilled at a location 1745 feet from the South line and 1455 from the West line in the NE/4 SW/4 (Unit K) of Section 15 to test the Delaware formation at a depth of approximately 4,000 feet.
- 3. Myco has sought and been unable to obtain a voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from the interest owners identified on Exhibit A to this application.
- 4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.
- 5. In order to permit Myco the opportunity to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and Myco should be designated the operator of the well.

WHEREFORE, Myco requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 7, 2008, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order:

- A. pooling all mineral interests in the subject spacing and proration unit;
- B. designating Myco operator of the unit and the well to be drilled thereon;
- C. authorizing Myco to recover its costs of deepening, equipping and recompleting the well;
- D. approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision to adjust the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- E. imposing the 200% risk penalty provided by Division Rule 19.15.1.35 against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of this well.

Application of Myco Industries, Inc. for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in all formations from the surface to the base of the Delaware formation underlying the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, to form a standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 40-acre spacing including but not limited to the Catclaw Delaware Pool. This unit is to be dedicated to the Basin 15 Federal Well No. 1, to be drilled at a location 1745 feet from the South line and 1455 feet from the West line in the NE/4 SW/4 (Unit K) of said Section 15 to test the Delaware formation at a depth of approximately 4,000 feet. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and, pursuant to NMRA 19.15.1.35, the imposition of a 200% risk charge against the working interest of any party that elects not to participate in this project. Said area is located approximately 8 miles west of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
