Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-6275-A approved the unorthodox location of the Texaco Inc. C. A. Loomis Federal Well No. 1 at a point 1600 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 5, Township 21 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, South Salt Lake-Morrow Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Subsequent to said order, Bass Enterprises Production Company became operator of the well, and has produced the well to depletion in the Morrow zone.
