

Dear Mr. Ramey:

At the hearing on the above case on February 16, 1984, Applicant sought the following amendments to the Application:

That Mesa Grande Resources, Inc., be named as operator 1. of the well, rather than E. Alex Phillips. Mesa Grande Resources is wholly owned by E. Alex Phillips.

2. Pooling of all mineral interests from the base (rather than the top) of the Mesaverde formation to the base of the Dakota formation; and

In the alternative to compulsory pooling, an order 3. approving a 160 acre non-standard proration unit in the SE1/4 of Section 26.

Mesa Grande Resources hereby withdraws its request for these three amendments, and requests that an Order be entered based on the Application as advertised and the evidence presented at the hearing. Therefore the case need not be readvertised.

At the hearing, Ernest Padilla, on behalf of Benson-Montin-Greer, objected to the proposed 160 acre non-standard unit. I have informed him by telephone that Mesa Grande Resources is withdrawing its request for the non-standard unit and the other amendments. He stated that his client had no objection to the compulsory pooling application.
