containing 160 acres, more or less.

By its Order No. R-3179-B, the New Mexico Oil Con-2. servation Division promulgated special rules and regulations for the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool, which provided, among other things, for 160-acre spacing units, with wells to be located within 150 feet of the center of each governmental guarter section.

3. Applicant proposes to drill its Vada State "17" No. 1 Well at a point located 660 feet from the north line and 2,615 feet from the west line of said Section 17, projected as an oil well.

4. The applicant seeks an exception to Order No. R-3179-B to permit the drilling of its well as aforesaid, and to dedicate an 80-acre unit to such well, consisting of E/2 NW/4 of said Section 17.

5.
