By this letter, Amoco Production Company ("Amoco") submits additional copies of the exhibits introduced into evidence, at a hearing held before you on June 8, 1983, in the captioned cases. The attached "List of Exhibits" identifies the exhibits and for each exhibit indicates the number of additional copies now being submitted.

At your request, Amoco is also submitting certain logs, and certain sundry notices concerning two of the captioned wells, for inclusion in the record in the captioned cases. Those logs and notices are identified as Exhibit Nos. 20-B, 21-B, 22-B, 23-B, 24-B, 20-C, 23-C and 24-C on the attached List of Exhibits. Amoco now requests that the exhibits just named be accepted into evidence and made part of the record in the captioned cases.

Amoco's district personnel have indicated that there was use of acids in the State Gas Com BW #1-B on April 21, 1982, and in the Cahn Gas Com #1-C on October 22, 1982. The uses just mentioned, however, were "maintenance type work" and were not for the purpose of stimulation, and accordingly, the reporting of those uses in Sundry Notices did not appear necessary.

I believe that when the exhibit copies now submitted are added to the copies already in your files, you will have the requisite number of copies on hand. However, please let me know if you need more copies of any exhibit.
