STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) seeks a compliance order against Southwestern, Inc. (Southwestern) as to the State VC #001 well. This is the second compliance case brought against Southwestern regarding this well.

On September 18, 2007, the OCD filed an application for a compliance order against Southwestern in Case 14007 alleging multiple violations. On February 25, 2008, the Director issued Order No. R-12909, ordering Southwestern to bring the State VC #001 well into compliance with 19.15.4.201 NMAC (the inactive well rule) on or before April 30, 2008. Southwestern failed to meet that deadline (or any extended deadline granted by the OCD), the OCD was authorized to plug the well, forfeit the applicable financial assurance, and collect a penalty in the amount of \$6,000. Southwestern has not returned the well to compliance.

The OCD brings this action to request an order formally assessing the penalty of \$6,000, and finding that Southwestern is in violation of an order requiring corrective action. Such a finding will put Southwestern out of compliance with 19.15.1.40 NMAC, allowing and in some situations requiring the OCD to deny certain privileges to the operator. In addition, Southwestern has not updated the financial assurance for the State VC #001 to meet the current financial assurance requirements. The OCD also requests that the order require Southwestern to post a financial assurance for the well in the correct amount by a date certain.


