A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now John Yuronka, individually and by his attorneys, Jasper & Buell, and applies to the Oil Conservation Division for an order to convert the Harrison A No. 2 well into a water disposal well and in support thereof states:

1. The applicant is the operator of the Harrison A No. 2 located in Section 29, Range 24 South, Township 37 East, and further located approximately 2310 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of said section.

2. At the present time said well is producing from the Langly-Mattix pool approximately ten (10) MCF of natural gas per day and approximately eighty (80) barrels of water per day and is uneconomical.

3. Applicant proposes to dispose of "salt water" from other wells he operates in the area into the Langly-Mattix pool through this well at perforations now at a depth of between 3,400 to 3,501 feet, inclusive.

Although applicant states this on information and belief, applicant is unaware of who the owner of the fee title to this land may be.

6. This matter may be heard by the Oil Conservation Division or by one of its examiners.

7. The granting of this application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.
