FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

<u>James Ranch No. 103, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This well will be drilled at a legal location being 330' FNL & 2,310' FWL, Section 36, T22S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 11,300' to test the Bone Spring and Delaware.

<u>James Ranch No. 104H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This well will be drilled at a legal location being 330' FNL & 990' FWL, Section 36, T22S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 12,300' to test the Delaware Formation.

<u>James Ranch No. 105H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This well will be drilled at a legal location being 2,228' FNL & 920' FWL, Section 36, T22S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 12,300' to test the Delaware Formation.
