If the OCD does not receive a pre-hearing statement from the applicant by the close of business on the Thursday before the hearing, the hearing may be continued or dismissed by order of the examiner. If a protesting party fails to submit a timely pre-hearing statement, the hearing may be continued at the applicant's request. The following cases will be heard by an Examiner.

Plan Pursuant to the New Mexico Water Quality Act, Hidalgo County, New Mexico. Raser Power Systems, LLC has filed an application for approval of a discharge plan pursuant to the New Mexico Water Quality Act for its proposed Lightning Dock Geothermal No. 1 geothermal power plant, to be located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 7, Township 25 South, Range 19 West, in Hidalgo County, New Mexico. The plant will be within the Animas River Valley approximately 10 miles south of Interstate Highway 10 on CR 3387 (east side of Geothermal Road). The discharge plan proposes construction of five Class V injection wells in the NE/4 and NW/4 of Section 18-25S-19W. Consideration will be given to well construction, monitoring, testing and operation, including potential for groundwater impacts.
