This is in response to your letter received by this office on September 25, 2008. The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) will participate in the scheduled hearing concerning the application for authority to inject into the wells described below.

These wells inject into Federal minerals; like approval will be required from the BLM prior to injection.

If these wells are to be used for commercial water disposal, a Right-of-Way (ROW) with a \$25,000 bond will be required for each well.

BLM has numerous compliance issues that have not been addressed by the operator.
