
MERIT ENERGY COMPANY'S APPLICATION FOR HEARING

Pursuant to 19.15.14.1206 NMAC, Merit Energy Company ("Merit Energy") requests a hearing on its applications for injection authority for the J.L. Keel B 77, H.E. West 35, and J.L. Keel B 57 wells located in Sections 8 and 9 of Township 17 South, Range 31 East in Eddy County. Merit Energy seeks to convert the wells for injection for purposes of expanding the Keel-West Waterflood Project.

Merit Energy requests that the Division set this matter for hearing on the October 2, 2008 Examiner Docket. A proposed publication notice of the hearing is attached.

The wells are located approximately 6 miles east of Loco Hills, New Mexico.
