

Dear Mr. Brooks:

Britt Pence of Vanguard has had discussions with Brad Bliss of Techsys regarding the two company's wells and well units. I understand that Mr. Bliss called Mr. Pence's office at 6:34 a.m. (Texas time) this morning, and left a message stating that Techsys would withdraw its protest of Vanguard's application on the State A Well No. 7 in return for Vanguard not objecting to Techsys' request for an unorthodox location and simultaneous dedication for the W.D. Grimes NCT-A Well No. 4. Mr. Bliss also said that he'd leave it up to Vanguard to send the appropriate letter to the Division; hence this letter. **This letter is being e-mailed to Mr. Bliss, so if he disagrees with the statements made herein I ask him to contact you directly.**

Vanguard would like to return its well to production, so a prompt order would be appreciated.
