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1 MR. WARNELL: Case 14312, application of
2 the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a compliance
3 order against Orbit Petroleum, Inc. Call for
4 appearances.

5 MS. MACQUESTEN: Gail MacQuesten appearing
6 for the Oil Conservation Division.

7 MR. WARNELL: Any other appearances? Ms.
8 MacQuesten, you may continue.

9 MS. MACQUESTEN: Mr. Examiner, this is a
10 plugging case. It was heard on May 14th. At that time
11 we thought we had actual notice to the operator by
12 service to the registered agent listed on the PRC
13 Website. After the hearing, the letters that were sent
14 to that agent were returned to the OCD marked "Address
15 unknown." I tried to contact the registered agent and
16 couldn't find them.

17 Because we were concerned that we had not
18 given appropriate notice to the operator, we had this
19 case put back on the calendar and advertised in the
20 newspaper. I'm here today to present you with affidavits
21 of publication from the two relevant newspapers, and I'd
22 ask you to adopt the record that was made on May 14th and
23 take the case under advisement.

24 MR. WARNELL: Let the record show that we
25 are accepting Exhibits 15 and 16 into the record. And if

1 there are no questions --

2 (Exhibits 15 and 16 were admitted.)

3 MR. BROOKS: What is the status of Orbit's
4 bankruptcy? Does anyone know?

5 MS. MACQUESTEN: I do not know.

6 MR. BROOKS: I haven't heard anything in a
7 while. What needs to be done on Orbit is to move for
8 relief from the automatic stay but it hasn't been done.
9 Okay. Thanks.

10 MR. WARNELL: Okay. If there's no other
11 questions, then Case Number 14312 will be taken under
12 advisement.
