APPLICATION OF SOUTHERN UNION PRODUCTION COMPANY FOR AN CREER FORCE-POOLING A STANDARD 160-ACRE GAS PRORATION UNIT IN THE TAPACITO-PICTURED CLIFFS GAS POOL, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE CONCLESSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on spril 19, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Lexico, before A. L. Porter, Jr., Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 5th day of May, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, A. L. Porter, Jr., and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Southern Union Production Company, is the owner and operator of Federal Lease No. N.M. 014856, comprising the N/2 SW/4 of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 3 West, NEPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant seeks an order force-pooling all mineral interests in the Tapacito-Fictured Cliffs Gas Pool in the S%/4 of said Section 2, in order to form a 160-acre gas proration unit.

(4) That inasmuch as denial of the subject application would deprive, or tend to deprive, the mineral interest owners in the above-described 160-acre tract of the opportunity to recover their just and equitable share of the hydrocarbons in the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, all mineral interests therein should be force-pooled.

(5) That the applicant should furnish the Commission with an itemized schedule of well costs upon completion of a well on the subject gas proration unit.

IT IS THEREFORE OR DERED:

That the interests of all persons having the right to drill for, produce, or share in the production of hydrocarbons from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool underlying the SN/4 of Section 2, Township 25 worth, wange 3 west, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Pexico, are hereby force-pooled to form a standard 160-acre gas proration unit comprising all of said acreage. Said unit is to be bedicated to a well to be located at an orthodox location thereon.

<u>PROVIDED HO.EVER</u>. That the proportionate share of the costs of development and operation of the pooled unit shall be borne by each consenting working interest owner in the same proportion to the total costs that his acreage bears to the total acreage in the pooled unit.



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<u>PROVIDED FURTHER</u>. That the proportionate share of the costs of development of the pocked unit, including a reasonable charge for supervision, shall be paid out of production by each non-consenting working interest owner and shall be 110 per cent of the same proportion to the total costs of drilling and completing the well that his acreage bears to the total acreage in the pooled unit.

<u>PROVIDED FURTHER</u>, That the snare of the costs for development of the pocked unit, as determined above, which is to be paid by the mineral interest owners shall be withheld only from the working interests' snare (7/2) of the revenues derived from the sale of the hydrocarbons produced from the well on the pooled unit. Royalty payments are not to be affected by the withholding of any funds for the purpose of paying out a proportionate share of the costs of development and operation of the pooled unit.

<u>PROVIDED FURTHER</u>, That the applicant shall furnish the Commission with an itemized schedule of well costs upon completion of a well on the subject gas proration unit.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
