- MR. WARNELL: We will call our next case,
- 2 Case 14347, application of Mewbourne Oil Company for
- 3 compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Call for
- 4 appearances?
- 5 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa
- 6 Fe representing the applicant. I am again submitting this
- 7 by affidavit.
- 8 MR. WARNELL: Mr. Bruce, you may proceed.
- 9 MR. BRUCE: Again, I submitted you three
- 10 exhibits, Mr. Examiner. Exhibit 1 is the affidavit of the
- 11 landman. Mewbourne Oil Company seeks to force pool mineral
- 12 interests from the surface to the base of the Yeso formation
- 13 underlying the Northwest quarter, Southwest quarter of
- 14 Section 15, 20 South, 25 East.
- The affidavit lists the interest owners and their
- 16 interests. As you can see, again, we are dealing with the
- 17 fee mineral owners, unleased mineral owners, who have
- 18 disappeared over the years. There is one person who was
- 19 locateable. Again, they take the usual steps to try to
- 20 track down these interest owners, and if you go back over
- 21 the last half, Mewbourne has forced pooled five or six well
- 22 units -- actually, in Sections 10 and 15, they force pooled
- 23 seven or eight well units, and they have been out here
- 24 examining title for quite some time and drilling a number of
- 25 wells. And these are mainly fee tracts, and there is a lot

- of people who disappeared a long time ago, and they cannot
- 2 locate them.
- 3 Attachment B is simply the proposal letter sent to
- 4 the locateable owner. Exhibit C is the AFE for the well.
- 5 It is about a \$700,000 well. It's a quite shallow well.
- 6 The overhead rates requested are \$4,000 a month for a
- 7 drilling well and \$400 for a producing well.
- 8 Exhibit 2 is my affidavit of notice. It was only
- 9 sent to Walter Parker, who did receive notice.
- 10 And, again, Exhibit 3 is the notice I published in
- 11 the Carlsbad newspaper. Again, it was published at the same
- 12 time as in the prior case, I think July 11. And, again, I
- 13 have not received the affidavit of publication from the
- 14 newspaper.
- I would move the admission of Exhibits 1 through
- 16 3, with the provision that I will substitute Exhibit 3 with
- 17 the affidavit of publication when I receive it.
- 18 MR. WARNELL: Okay. We will admit Exhibits 1
- 19 through 3 and wait for your publication.
- 20 (Exhibits 1 through 3 admitted.)
