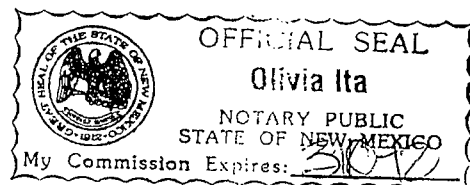

Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that EOG Resources, Inc. has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking the creation of a 160-acre nonstandard spacing and proration unit comprised of the N/2 NE/4 of Section 18 and the N/2 NW/4 of Section 17, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. EOG proposes to dedicate this non-standard spacing units to its Sand Tank "18" Federal Com Well No. 2H to be drilled to the Bone Spring formation from a surface location 430 feet from the North line and 2260 feet from the East line of said Section 18 and then drilled in an easterly direction to a bottomhole location 430 feet from the North line and 2310 feet from the West line of said Section 17 to test the Bone Spring formation.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on August 6, 2009. The hearing will be held in Porter Hall at the Division's Santa Fe offices located at 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B to file a Pre-Hearing Statement with the Oil Conservation Division's Santa Fe office, five days in advance of a scheduled hearing. This statement must include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.
