Dear Ms. Husband:

Reference is made to your request to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (Division) received October 3, 2003, to increase the surface injection pressure on the subject well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted in early October 2003. Results of this test have been reviewed and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are hereby authorized to inject water up to the following maximum surface tubing pressure.

Well and Location	Maximum Surface Injection Pressure
Eva E. Blinebry Well No. 20 API:30-025-31677	1,100 PSIG
This well is located in Section 34, Township 23 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
