1 to be picking or choosing who hears the cases. All my  
2 examiners are very capable of hearing any case, except  
3 when it comes to the legal part. I have no idea.

4               So we are going to seek to develop a rotation,  
5 hearing rotation, and we stick by it. But if you have a  
6 need to request something because it's really  
7 particularly important to you, I will base it on legal.  
8 We are all technical examiners and are very competent to  
9 handle the technical issues, but if it's legal and you  
10 want to request David to be there, I will comply with  
11 that. But I don't want anybody picking and choosing who  
12 hears a case or not.

13              I wanted to say that there's a lot of in-house  
14 things we do, but these are the ones I want to  
15 communicate to you guys. Are there any questions or  
16 comments, you know, adverse effects or something? We  
17 have to make sure you know how we are handling our  
18 operations.

19              Then we go about our business of today. Today  
20 we will consider Docket Number 24-09. I guess everybody  
21 knows who is sitting at this table. We don't need any  
22 introductions. First off, we read off all the  
23 continuances and dismissals. On page 1, Case Number  
24 14320 is continued to August 20th. On page 4, Case  
25 Number 14337 is continued indefinitely. This is a case

1 of the injection that is not in compliance. That's why  
 2 it's continued indefinitely until they are in compliance.  
 3 Case Number 14331 is continued to August 6th.

4 The next page, page 5, Case Number 14332 is  
 5 continued to July 23rd; ~~14333~~ is continued to July 23rd;  
 6 14339 is continued to July 23rd; 13940 is continued to  
 7 September 3. On page 6, Case Number 14329 is continued  
 8 to August 6th. Case Number 14319 is continued to July  
 9 23rd. The last page, Case Number 14271 is dismissed.  
 10 Are there any other continuances or dismissals?

11 MR. CARR: Mr. Examiner, on page 6 of the  
 12 docket there are two cases, one Nadel and Gussman Heyco  
 13 and the next one for Cimarex. It looks like the parties  
 14 have reached an agreement. We were hoping we could  
 15 dismiss those, Mr. Kellahin and I, but we would ask that  
 16 it be continued to the 23rd. They have agreed to things  
 17 and are now signing documents, so we're anticipating on  
 18 that day that it can be dismissed. So those two cases.

19 MR. EZEANYIM: Let the record reflect that  
 20 Case Number 14311 is continued to September --

21 MR. CARR: 23rd of July.

22 MR. EZEANYIM: -- July 23rd. Case Number  
 23 14322 is continued to July the 23rd. Any other  
 24 dismissals or continuances? Okay.


