

The Commissioner of Public Lands has this date approved the resignation of Chevron U.S.A. Inc., and the designation of Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. as the successor unit operator of this unit. This change in operators is effective September 1, 2004. In accordance with this approval, Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. is now responsible for all operations and the reporting of all production from the unit.
