We are in receipt of your resignation/designation of successor unit operator, wherein Yates Petroleum Corporation, has resigned as unit operator of the West Loco Hills Grayburg No. 4 Sand Unit and designated EnerVest Operating, L.L.C. as the successor unit operator.
