

This letter is to advise you that Crossland Oil & Gas has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking the compulsory pooling of all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation, in certain spacing and proration units in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Crossland proposes to dedicate the referenced pooled units to its proposed Empire A Federal Re-entry Well No. 2, to be drilled by re-entering a well at a standard location in the SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 27.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner at 8:15 a.m. on November 6, 2003, at the Division's offices located at 1220 South Saint Francis Drive in Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases have been requested by the Division (Memorandum 2-90) to file a Prehearing Statement substantially in the form prescribed by the Division. Prehearing statements should be filed by 4:00 o'clock p.m. on the Friday before a scheduled hearing.




