This is my statement of objection and protest. I Rosanne Williams of the above address will appear, without legal representation, as a concerned citizen on Thursday, 6-11-2009, 8:15 am. 1) It is unfair to ask Kirtland residents and the parents of approximately 2000 school children who attend the schools within the mile radius of the proposed well site to attend a hearing in Santa Fe, N.M. 2) I need more information about how it is more "Environmentally friendly" to pump acid gas, a carbon emission, 1.25 miles into the Entrada Sandstone, than to burn it off into the atmosphere? 3) A project of this magnitude needs questions answered in Kirtland, New Mexico, near land holders, before the application is approved, not after the application is approved. 4) Has there been any studies on the public health implications of underground acid wells?
