



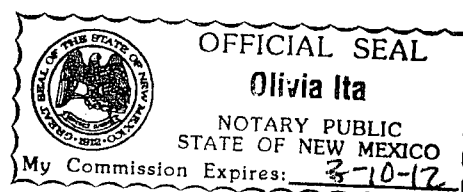

Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Mewbourne Oil Company has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking the force pooling of all mineral interests from the surface to the top of the Bone Spring formation in all formations and pools in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 18, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant proposes to dedicate the pooled units to its Wyatt Draw "18" K Well No. 1. to be drilled as a wildcat oil well at a standard location 1650 feet from the North and West Lines (Unit F) of said Section 18.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner at 8:15 AM on March 4, 2010. The hearing will be held in Porter Hall in the Oil Conservation Division's Santa Fe Offices located at 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B to file a Pre-Hearing Statement with the Oil Conservation Division's Santa Fe office, four days in advance of a scheduled hearing, but at least on the Thursday preceding the hearing. This statement must include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.

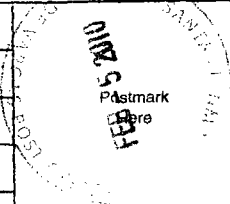
