1 MR. FESMIRE: At this time, we will
2 go on the record in the regularly scheduled New
3 Mexico Oil Conservation Commission meeting scheduled
4 for April 8, 2010. The record should reflect that
5 Commissioners Bailey, Olson, and Fesmire are all
6 present. We, therefore, have a quorum.

7 The first order of business before
8 the Commission today is the adoption of the minutes
9 of the March 11, 2010 Commission meeting. Have the
10 commissioners had a chance to review the minutes as
11 presented by the secretary?

12 MS. BAILEY: I need to abstain since
13 I was not present during that hearing.

14 MR. FESMIRE: The record should
15 reflect that Commissioner Bailey was not present
16 during the hearing and has abstained from adopting
17 the minutes.

18 MR. OLSON: Yes, I have reviewed
19 them, but I did make a minor edit --

20 MS. DAVIDSON: Yes.

21 MR. OLSON: -- in the minutes, and I
22 think they accurately reflect our meeting, and I move
23 that they be adopted.

24 MR. FESMIRE: Secretary Davidson, you
25 have adopted the commissioner's --

1 MS. DAVIDSON: Changes, yes.

2 MR. FESMIRE: -- change in the copy
3 presented to us?

4 MS. DAVIDSON: Yes.

5 MR. FESMIRE: I, too, have reviewed
6 the minutes, and they accurately reflect my
7 recollection of the events at the meeting, so I would
8 second the motion. All of those in favor of signing
9 the minutes as presented by the secretary signify by
10 saying aye.

11 MR. OLSON: Aye.

12 MR. FESMIRE: Aye. Let the record
13 reflect that Commissioners Olson and Fesmire voted to
14 adopt the minutes as presented, that the minutes will
15 be signed, have been signed, and transmitted to the
16 secretary for recording.

17 MS. DAVIDSON: Thank you.

18 MR. FESMIRE: The next order of
19 business before the Commission is Case Number 13 --
20 14326. It is the De Novo Application of the New
21 Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a Compliance
22 Order against Nacogdoches Oil and Gas. The
23 Commission has deliberated and directed counsel to
24 draft an order in this case -- wait a minute.

25 MS. BAILEY: The case was dismissed.

1 MR. FESMIRE: Oh, I'm sorry. The
2 case was dismissed. Secretary, is there an order to
3 that effect?

4 MS. DAVIDSON: You signed the order
5 as commission chair.

6 MR. FESMIRE: Okay.

7 MS. DAVIDSON: It has already been
8 dismissed.

9 MR. FESMIRE: Okay. So Case Number
10 14326 has been dismissed.


