The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) received your letter dated April 27, 2010, regarding the referenced subject on April 29, 2010. The OCD has reviewed your request and hereby extends the date to commence the drilling of this well to May 15, 2011, <u>as long as the operator does not use this extension to hold monies already paid by participating working interest owners.</u>

The operator shall do the following for any future request for extension of time to drill this well:

- (a) Give notice to all the original locatable interest owners in the pooled unit;
- (b) Wait for twenty (20) days to give the interest owners the opportunity to object or not;
- (c) If no objection is received after 20 days, then the operator shall submit the request with proof of notice; and
- (d) If any objection is received, the operator shall set the case for hearing before any extension may be granted


## Dear Mr. Fesmire:

The above order, as extended, requires the operator to commence the proposed well on or before May 18, 2010. See Exhibit A. The Division granted the extension with the proviso that it not be used to hold money paid by a pooled working interest owner. The only pooled interest owner, Tamarack Petroleum Co., Inc., was never sent an election letter. JTD Resources, LLC has now completed and conducted substantial testing on an offset well, and decided in the last two weeks to move forward with the drilling of the above well. Yesterday it hand delivered an election letter to Tamarack Petroleum Co., Inc. It is also actively seeking a rig to drill the well. As a result, JTD Resources, LLC requests a final 30 day extension of the commencement date in order to (1) allow the election period to run, and (2) contract for a rig.
